



## **SSAT Flex Test with Buckley Education Frequently Asked Questions**

*Buckley Education is an authorized Flex Test Center.  
As such we can potentially offer the test, as schedules permit,  
on any day of the year other than SSAT national test dates.*

### **What is a Flex Test?**

The SSAT Flex Test is given to an individual or group on any date other than the Standard dates. For more information, please visit <https://ssat.org/flex>.

### **What grade levels can take the Flex Test?**

The Flex Test is offered for grades 5-7 (Middle Level Test) and 8-11 (Upper Level Test). Test registration corresponds to the grade of current enrollment. The Flex Test is not available for the Elementary Level.

### **Does Buckley Education receive test scores?**

No. Buckley Education does not receive any test scores. It is the responsibility of the family to request a score report through the SSAT Portal and have it sent directly to the school(s) to which the student is applying.

### **How do I send my score report to schools?**

### **What dates are available for the Flex Test?**

Using our [pre-registration form](#), you will be able to request a first, second and third choice date. We will do our best to accommodate your request as close as possible to one of your requested times. Your flexibility in alternate dates and times is greatly appreciated. If you are requesting a weekend date, it is also helpful if you can provide a weekday for one of your choices. In addition, we have some pre-scheduled test dates you can select.

### **What time of day is the Flex Test held?**

We offer a morning test at 9:00 am, and an afternoon test at 1:30 pm.

**How far in advance do I need to schedule a Flex Test?**

A date needs to be requested, at minimum, one week in advance. As Educational Consultants, our schedules are also booked with client meetings. The more notice you can provide for the scheduling of your Flex Test, the better.

**What is the Testing Year for Flex Tests?**

The testing year runs from August 1-July 31.

**Does Buckley Education’s testing fee include the fee for the Flex Test?**

No. Buckley Education’s testing fee is separate from the Flex Test fee. Buckley Education’s fee covers the cost of a flexible testing date, smaller testing environment, and a staff member to proctor the test.

**How many students will there be in the testing room?**

Our testing room accommodates a maximum of four students. For any given test, there may be between 1-4 students testing.

**What does your testing room look like?**

**What are Buckley Education’s Testing Fees?**

- \$500 for a weekday (small group) test
- \$650 for a weekend (small group) test
- \$1500 for a weekday individual test
- \$1950 for a weekend individual test

**What should I bring to the test?**

- Admission ticket (print from SSAT website after registration completed)
- Photo ID (such as School ID card or passport)
- Water bottle and snack

**Note: If a student is approved for accommodations, it is the family’s responsibility to provide the necessary materials.**



**When should I arrive to the test?**

Please arrive no later than 10 minutes prior to the test start time. Our proctor will be on site 10 minutes before the start time.

**What happens if I am late to the test?**

We cannot delay the start of the test, as multiple students may be testing at the same time, For this reason, if a student does not arrive within 10 minutes of the start time, they will not be permitted to test.

**Where is the bathroom?**

Within our office building at 1204 Burlingame Avenue, there is a bathroom for males and a bathroom for females.
